

PREFACE

Mrs. Margaret Roberts Hodges (Mrs. George W.) discovered in various places in Maryland important records covering the Colonial and Revolutionary periods in American history. She transcribed much of the same and presented a valuable series of Maryland Revolutionary manuscript volumes to the Library of the National Society, Daughters of the American Revolution. The proper officers of the latter organization, the Maryland Historical Society, and also patriotic individuals have very kindly and fully assisted the plan to publish such materials by placing at our disposal numerous important unpublished records of Maryland. Amongst these individuals Mr. Caleb Clarke Magruder, Jr., deserves especial thanks for furnishing the records and abstracts herein published upon pages 25 to 36. The latter are hitherto unknown and inaccessible records of civil services, and are of special value in supporting applications for membership in the various patriotic societies. The entire contents of Part One are valuable for this purpose.

Invaluable early Maryland records may be in the hands of librarians and individuals throughout the Nation, and extensive benefit may result from having such brought to the attention of the undersigned for inclusion in the plan to make some of such records more generally accessible.

The selected records are to be published in a series of pamphlets, as the subscriptions may justify, in limited edition and each pamphlet containing a *full index*. Part One is herewith offered to all who are interested in Maryland history, and subscriptions will be entered for the proposed series. There is a close relation between this series and the materials contained in "*Maryland Records—Brumbaugh*," of which Vol. I was published in 1915.

The Act of Assembly, 5 February, 1777, required that the Oath of Fidelity and Support be taken by all citizens, especially all holding positions of trust, all voting at any election, all transacting business in Maryland; and even citizens of one county who transacted business in another county were required to record their Oath in the latter county—see Plates I-IV. The "Test Oath," or "Oath of Fidelity and Support," was most important in Revolutionary times, and could not be lightly taken.

In February Session, 1777, No. 1, we find:

Resolved, That Messrs. Thomas Brooke Hodgkin, Wm. Wilkins and John Johnson,—be appointed a board of auditors—"by taking the oath of fidelity to this state, and an oath well, diligently and faithfully to execute the duty of their office agreeable to this resolve and by subscribing their belief in the Christian religion, etc.

Jan. 21, 1778^b—"The Committee appointed to devise effectual means to prevent persons disaffected to the interests of the United States from being employed in any of the important offices thereof, beg leave to report the following Resolutions;" etc.

Feb. 3, 1778.^c The Congress passed the resolution based upon the foregoing report:

Resolved, That every officer who holds or shall hereafter hold a commission or office from Congress, shall take and subscribe the following oath or affirmation:

I, _____, do acknowledge the United States of America to be free, independent and sovereign states, and declare that the people thereof owe no allegiance or obedience to George the Third, King of Great Britain; and I renounce, refuse and abjure any allegiance or obedience to him; and I do swear (or affirm) that I will, to the utmost of my power, support, maintain and defend the said United States against the said King George the Third and his heirs and successors, and his and their abettors, assistants and adherents, and will serve the United States in the office of _____ which I now hold, with fidelity according to the best of my skill and understanding. So help me God.^d

The various states were also directed to take similar action, immediately. The resolutions passed 21 Oct., 1776, prescribing the form of an oath or affirmation were also repealed.

*A LIST OF PERSONS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY WHO HAVE TAKEN THE FOLLOWING OATH BEFORE THE DIFFERENT MAGISTRATES AS MENTIONED BELOW; AND RETURNED BY THEM TO MONTGOMERY COURT."

"OATH OF FIDELITY AND SUPPORT."

"I do sware I do not hold myself bound to yield any Allegience or obedience to the King of Great Britain his heirs or Successors and that I will be true and faithful to the State of Maryland and will to the utmost of my power, Support maintain and defend the Freedom and Independence thereof and the Government as now established against all open enemies and secret and traterous Conspriaces and will use my utmost endeavours to disclose and make known to the Governor or some one of the Judges or Justices thereof all Treasons or Treaterous Conspærances, attempts or Combinations against this State or the Government thereof which may come to my Knowledge so help me God.

ACT OF ASSEMBLY, 5 FEBRUARY, 1777.

"At a Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, convened by the Council of Safety, and begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on Wednesday the fifth of February, in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven, the following Laws were enacted."

"An Act to punish certain crimes and misdemeanors, and to prevent the growth of toryism.

Chapter XX, Sec. XIII. "That every senator, delegate to congress or assembly, member of the council, electors of the senate, and every attorney at law, and all civil officers, and all persons holding any office of trust or profit in this state, shall take, repeat and subscribe the following oath of fidelity and support to this state, before he acts as such, or enters into the execution of his office, to wit: I, A. B. do swear that I do not hold myself bound to yield any allegiance or obedience to the King of Great Britain, his heirs or successors, and that I will be true and faithful to the state of Maryland, and will, to the utmost of my power, support, maintain and defend the freedom and independence thereof, and the government as now established, against all open enemies and secret and traitorous conspiracies, and will use my utmost endeavors to disclose and make known to the governor, or some one of the judges or justices thereof, all treasons of traitorous conspiracies, attempts or combinations against this state or the government thereof, which may come to my knowledge; so help me God. (See also pp. 1, 11)

Section XIV. "That every member of the present general assembly, and the council, shall take, repeat and subscribe, the said oath, immediately after the passing this Act, and before he acts as such; and if any person now holding any office of trust or profit, shall not, within three months after the end of this present session, take, repeat and subscribe, the same oath, or affirmation if a quaker, menonist or dunker, he shall be ipso facto disqualified to hold such office, and the office of such person shall be filled agreeable to its institution."

Sec. XV, "And be it enacted That every Voter for Delegates or Sheriffs, or for Electors of the Senate, if required, and every other Person required by Law to take the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State, shall take, repeat, and subscribe the same Oath, or if a Quaker, Menonist or Dunker, shall solemnly, sincerely, and truly declare and affirm thereto in the Words thereof."

Sec. XVIII, "Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall extend to such persons who from religious principles have not subscribed or shall not subscribe the association."

Sec. XIX, "And be it enacted, That this Act shall be publicly read by the Clerk of the General Court, and by the Clerk of every County Court in this State, at their next Court respectively, immediately after impanelling the Grand Jury, and also by every Minister, Teacher or Preacher of the Gospel, immediately after divine Service, at every Church, Chapel, or Meeting-House, where they officiate, on some Sunday in the Month of May next; and every Clerk, Minister, Teacher or Preacher, failing so to do, shall forfeit and pay the Sum of five Pounds, to be recovered with Costs by the Informer before any Justice of the Peace of the County where the Offence shall be committed."
